President's Speech**

Dear Host and Leaders at CIWA and PLU,

About two years ago at the same beautiful Silver Cloud Hotel, leaders at CIWA and PLU including Professors Manfredi and Zhou hosted over “brave” 20 plus scholars from the ACPSS, all US-based institutions, who attended the 26th annual conference. At that time, the pandemic was still raging across the world and few institutions in the US dared to host conferences. But leaders at CIWA and PLU not only welcome ACPSS scholars but also generously sponsored and hosted the conference. All participants had expressed great appreciation for our host.

Right after the end of our last joint conference, leaders at CIWA and PLU told me that they would like to host another joint conference with ACPSS. This weekend is the second joint conference between our host at CIWA and PLU and ACPSS. All ACPSS participants and I will have no doubt that it will be another successful conference and it will leave long lasting good memories.

This year, while about half of all registered conference participants cannot physically attend due to visa and funding issues, we still have around 30 ACPSS members coming to PLU for the conference and stay in the same hotel. Two scholars from China have managed to come to

the US to attend the conference. One of the reasons behind the visa issues is the increasingly strained tensions between China and the US. The conference theme for this year is “China Facing More Challenges.” Many participants from a variety of disciplines including history, political science, social science, and Chinese studies will address this issue through different perspectives.

On behalf of ACPSS members who are attending the 28th conference or who plan to join online, I want to express my deepest appreciation and thanks to the meticulous preparation, generous support, and timely updates of our host at CIWA and PLU, especially leaders Paul, Prof. Zhou Jun, Geoffrey, and Mikel. I hope and am sure that this conference will be another big success in our cooperation. My appreciations also go to current ACPSS board members for their timely and excellent work in organizing ACPSS activities and preparing this conference and many former ACPSS presidents and board members especially Professors Patrick Shan, Zhang Jie, and Ma Yuxin for their persistent assistance to ACPSS.

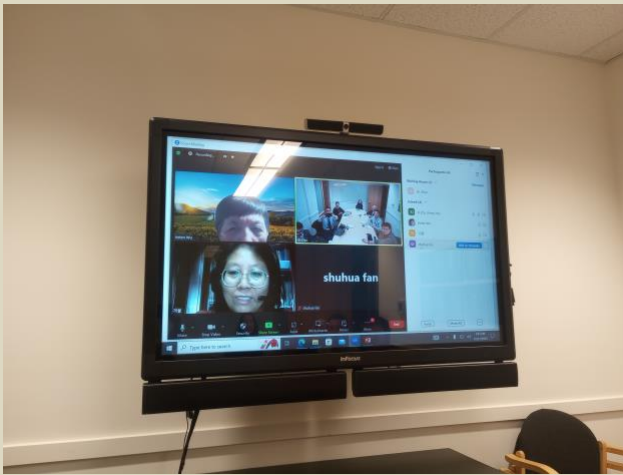
